The National service Scheme (NSS) is a central sector scheme of Government of India, Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports. It provides opportunity to the students to take part in various government led community service activities & programmes. The sole aim of NSS is to provide hands on experience to young students in delivering community service. On 1st August, 2017 NSS unit was started with 100 volunteers in Govt. College for Women Pali, Rewari. Two types of activities are conducted in NSS- Regular activities (120 hours) and Annual Special Camp (120 hours). All the volunteers have to serve in NSS for at least 2 years for 240 hours to get certification from the university under the signature of Vice Chancellor and programme coordinator.

Library

The library caters to the needs of open the horizons of knowledge of teachers and students by providing access to books and journals on respective subjects, general awareness books, biographies and autobiographies of great leader, saints and social workers, popular novels, story books, newspapers, magazines, periodicals etc. It inculcate the habit of reading and learning among the teachers and students which further not only update their knowledge but also increase their power of critical thinking and creativity.

- A reading hall with 12 Reading table, 90 Chairs, 02 Magazine stands and 03 News Paper stands has been provided within the library where users can read books, magazines and newspapers. Library issues books to students and teachers as per their needs.
- Now library of this college is fully automated which provides a facility of easy access of books. Internet facility is provided in the library.
- > 03 Photocopiers and 03 Printers also have been provided in the library.
- A good number (3414) text books and reference books are kept in this library for reading and learning of students and teachers.
- Four dailies- The Hindu, Amar Ujala and Dainik Bhaskar Tribuneare subscribed in the library to acquire day to day knowledge and current update for students and teachers.
- ➤ The library has been strengthened this year by adding all books with automation of books.
- ➤ Wi-fi connection has been installed in library. The library has been made air conditioned with installation of four tower AC in the library.
- ➤ One vacuum cleaner has been provisioned in the library for keeping the books and bookrakes dust free.
- ➤ 04 monthly Magazines- Pratiyogita Darpan and Samanya Gyan Daepan, New India Samachar, reliance drishti(Braile) have been subscribed in the library for the students to enhance their knowledge.
- ➤ 05 Journals, the Journal of Haryana Studies and the Kurukshetra International Research Journal, Himmachal Pradesh university journal, Summer Hills, The interior have been subscribed in the library to inculcate research orientation in students and teachers.
