The purpose of this programme is to pave the way for Haryana Educators to shape and implement world class techniques, they think would benefit students and staff within their individual institutions.

The main aim of the project is to prepare students and faculties for National Education Policy and also for placement, selfemployment, Entrepreneurship and Incubation. By acquiring the globalized teaching and training, these candidates would also have an excellent set of Interpersonal skills as well as the practical skills so that they would be better placed to deal with a variety of stakeholders, both nationally and internationally. When faculty and students integrate intercultural materials into their educational experience, the educational Institute becomes more adaptable to a growing diverse student body, as new approaches, ideas, and different experiences are introduced, thus infusing a global approach to teaching and training.

Faculty members, students and the Institutions themselves would enjoy knowledge and skills sharing, enabling them to impart more

global and practical skills and knowledge to the students, to be more competitive in the age of globalization. The exchange scheme is devised in a way whereby the faculty and students are expected to spend up to two Weeks in the host institution to share, learn and deliver best practices on curriculum development, innovation & technology, quality assurance process and engagement with industry & employer.

Cambridge Regional College is a leading college of Cambridge University which offers courses for school learners, professional training and community courses etc. This college is among top 10 colleges as per the newly published league table of Further Education Colleges in England. The courses offered by CRC are designed to fit around the current requirements of the employees.

The overall aims of this exercise are as follows:

- To learn, share and deliver best practice on employability skills, skill base learning curriculum development and class/program implementation
- To understand requirements and needs in Equality, Diversity and Safeguarding for a diverse range of students including cultural awareness.
- To embed, develop and implement Quality Assurance, Innovation Technology & Connecting Employer & Industry.
- To put together provision of a vast set of programme learning materials and guides that can be adapted for specific institution types or delivery methods.

3. Criteria for the selection of faculty : M.M 100 Marks

- i) Experience – at least 10 years (Regular Government Service). In case of Skill University, this condition may be waived off.
- ii) Annual Confidential Reports (preferably last 5 years)- M.M. 50 Marks
 - For each Outstanding -10 Marks
 - For Very Good -07 Marks
 - For Good -04 Marks
- iii) Online Essay Writing (1200 words) -30 Marks
 - Online essay writing (750 words) -20 Marks

The selection exercise will be completely online including essay writing. For essay writing, online test center will be set up in a college in each district for test. This test will be monitored by the Principal of the College. Details of centres will be shared shortly.

All eligible students and faculty members as per above criteria will make an application online before 22nd September, 2023. The online link for application for students is <https://erp.highereduhry.ac.in> and the online link for application for faculty is <https://mis.highereduhry.ac.in> .

- ❖ All the Principals will mark the students and faculty as participants on ERP Portal and MIS Portal respectively.
- ❖ Students and Faculty should possess the valid Indian Passport.

The application will be closed on 22nd September, 2023 and tentative date of essay writing will be 26th & 27th September, 2023.
